In ceremonies Friday

167 seniors receive diplomas

Globe High School will graduate 167 at ceremonies beginning at 8 p.m. Friday at the high school stadium.

The Globe High School Band, under the direction of Ronald Howell, will play "War March of the Priests" by Mendelssohn for the class processional. After the seniors are in their places the "Star Spangled Banner" will be played.

Leslie Anne Gant will give the invocation followed by the salutatory speech by Pamela Renee Park. Her topic will be "A New Responsibility."

The senior triple trio will sing "You'll Never Walk Alone" by Richard Rogers. Participating seniors are Nancy Ann

CLASS SPEAKERS are next on the program. They are James Francis Vanell who will speak on "A Valuable Service" and Jane Ann Lopez speaking on "To Live in a World."

Two numbers will be presented by the concert choir under the direction of Ken Brink. They will sing "My Land Is a Good Land" by Eric Anderson and "Mem'ries Vanish Never" arranged by Walter Ehret.

"In Pursuit of Excellence" is the title of the valedictory speech to be delivered by Miss Bozzola after which Hugh O. Summers, principal of high school, will present the class.

PRESENTATION of diplomas will be by Elwood Miller, superintendent of Globe Public Schools, assisted by Roland Corriveau and James Harbison, school board members.

Following the presentation of diplomas the Class of 1971 will sing the Alma Mater Hymn, "Orange and Black," accompanied by the band and concert choir.

William Frederick Bishop will give the benediction. The audience is asked to remain seated for the class recessional to "Pomp and Circumstance" by the band.

PRECEDING graduating ceremonies will be a band concert at 7:30.
